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Chip seal maintenance on County OO between Hwy 441 and Buchanan Rd

The Outagamie County Highway Department will be performing a chip seal and fog seal operation on County OO (North Ave) between State Highway 441 and Buchanan Road in the Village of Little Chute. This project is scheduled to begin Thursday August 2nd and last through August 8, 2018, weather depending.

The chip seal consists of a layer of crushed stone placed on top of an application of liquid asphalt to reduce roadway deterioration and to prolong the life of the pavement. The fog seal is an additional layer of liquid asphalt used to better hold the stone chips in place.

County OO will be reduced to 1 lane eastbound and westbound during active operation. Local access will generally be maintained but motorists should expect some delays.

Planned schedule:

Thursday August 2: Liquid asphalt and stone chips will be applied.

Friday August 3: Crews will sweep loose stones from the road surface.

Tuesday August 7: Fog seal will be applied between Washington St and Buchanan Rd.

Wednesday August 8: Pavement markings will be painted.

Please be mindful of loose chips and proceed SLOWLY through the project work zone.

Chip seal maintenance may result in loose stones temporarily on the roadbed. Once the chip seal has cured, crews will sweep the highway to clear away loose stones. Motorists are urged to take extra caution, drive slowly, and allow additional space between vehicles to prevent damage from any loose stone chips.

When the fog seal is applied it must be fully cured before traffic is allowed on it. **Motorists should expect to be temporarily stopped or delayed 30 minutes or more, depending on drying conditions, to allow the application to cure.**

Access to and from County N at Freedom Road and at Madison St will be maintained during the fog seal operations. However, side road intersections and driveways will be temporarily closed during the fog seal. Please plan ahead for all personal and business travel. Use other local streets to avoid the work zone when possible.

We have attempted to contact all properties with direct access to this project; however, we may have missed some.
