## Village of Little Chute Consolidates Polling Locations

Little Chute, WI – The Village of Little Chute announced changes in polling places for the April 7<sup>th</sup> election due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. We apologize for the late change, but we are taking the necessary steps and precautions to protect the health of the public and our election team. Additionally, due to a lack of poll workers, this was the decision we had to make in order to effectively administer the upcoming election.

All wards for the April 7<sup>th</sup> election will vote at the Little Chute Civic Center. The Little Chute Civic Center is located at 625 Grand Ave, Little Chute, WI 54140.

We will take the necessary precautions to ensure the health and safety of our poll workers and the general public on Election Day. We will deploy appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) and take necessary steps to limit interaction between the electors and poll workers.

Even though polling places will be open on Election Day, the Village of Little Chute urges voters to vote absentee. We want everyone who is eligible and who wants to vote to be able to do so safely. Absentee voting will greatly reduce traffic at polling places on Election Day, which will make social distancing much easier and will create a safer environment for poll workers and those who do decide to vote in person on April 7<sup>th</sup>.

Voters will be able to drop off their absentee ballots at the Little Chute Civic Center utilizing the secure library book drop the located at the Little Chute Civic Center/Little Library. Voters will be able to utilize this drop off process to ensure their ballot is returned by Election Day starting Thursday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>. Voters can also utilize this drop off location and service on Election Day until polls close at 8 PM. Election staff will be monitoring the secure library drop box for ballots throughout the days ahead and on Election Day.
