REGISTRATION INFORMATION

PROGRAM REGISTRATION PROCESS

Program registration begins Friday, August 1 at 8:00 a.m.

Programs are open to Little Chute resident/taxpayers and non-residents.

→ ONLINE REGISTRATION

Families have the ability to register for programs at any time, and it also increases your chances of getting into the classes you want. Go to www.littlechutewi.org/recreation and click on the Register Online button. If you already have a family account created, log in to your account to register for programs. If you forgot your password, call our office and we can reset it for you (please do not create another family account). If you do not have a family account set up yet, click on tab to create your family account (new accounts need department approval before you can register for a program). Once you complete your registration and have paid with a credit card, you will receive an email confirmation.

 WALK-IN REGISTRATION

Registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve walk-in basis at the Little Chute Park & Rec Dept (108 W. Main Street – 2nd floor) during regular weekday office hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Payment must be made by cash or personal check only.



ELIGIBILITY & FEES

Village of Little Chute services are supported by village resident tax dollars, which allows residents to receive a discount on most programs and services. All programs list a Little Chute Resident fee as well as a Non-Resident fee. The Little Chute resident fee is for families who reside at an address within the Village of Little Chute tax parcel boundaries. *Note: Non-resident children who school choice to Little Chute do not qualify for the resident rate.*

AGE GRADE REQUIREMENTS

Children must meet the recreation program age/grade requirement by the first day of the program in order to register. Falsification of any information in family account, including address, kids in family, school grade, or dates of birth will lead to removal of program(s) with no refund of program fees!

CANCELLATIONS & CHANGES

Programs listed each have a minimum number of persons required to run the activity. We reserve the right to cancel a program and issue a full refund if there are not a sufficient number of registrants to justify the expense of that activity. No refunds will be given for activities canceled due to inclement weather or field conditions.

LATE REGISTRATIONS

Registration deadline for each program is listed in its description. After the deadline, registrations only accepted if space is available. Contact the Park & Rec Dept to inquire about late sign up for a program.

REFUND POLICY

Full refund of recreation program fees are made if Park & Rec cancels a program or the participant provides a medical excuse from their doctor. 50% fee credit to family account may be issued if family contacts the Park & Rec Dept., by phone or in person, by 4:30 p.m. at least two weeks prior to the start of the class (excludes wine walk, little stars & chute-ing stars). Refunds will not be issued for unattended classes.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Every Kid Counts is a fund that is available to children of Little Chute residents/taxpayers who, for family financial reasons, would be unable to participate in recreation and/or aquatic programs. An application form can be downloaded at www.littlechutewi.org/recreation or you can pick up a form at the Little Chute Park & Rec. Completed form must be returned with the required proof of eligibility. Applications processed on a first-come, first-serve basis until funds depleted

MILITARY DISCOUNT PROGRAM

In gratitude for their service to our country, discounted fees are available to all Village of Little Chute families with a family member currently deployed overseas. A military family is defined as all persons currently residing at the same address who are directly related to the military person (spouse, child, parents). Military families shall receive a 50% reduction in fees for individual recreation programs. Appropriate documentation is required to verify military service.

LITTLE STARS DANCE TEAM

Entering 3rd - 5th grade

This is a **competitive dance team** for younger kids who love dance! The dance team will practice on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. starting in late September to learn skills and technique that will help them become successful dancers. Team will learn a competitive pom routine and will perform in the LC Christmas Parade (12/1), and at two local dance competitions (LC Invite 12/13 & Kaukauna Invite 1/17/26).

This is a competitive dance team, so we ask that parents discuss the weekly practice commitments with their child (an occasional practice absence is understandable but dancer must get caught up on routine by next class) and the required commitment to attend all three performances.

If your child is interested in trying out for this competitive dance team, join us for our parent/dancer meeting Monday, August 18 at 5:30 p.m. in Room S3 of Little Chute Civic Center.

Following the meeting, dancers will have practice from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. to start learning dance skills. Dancers will meet again Tuesday, August 19 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. to work on dance skills. Tryouts will be held on Wednesday, August 20 starting at 6:00 p.m. (tryout times assigned by coach). **Dancers will be cut during tryouts.**

Registration fee for selected dancers will be \$185 for LC Resident and \$195 for Non-Resident, with full payment due by 8/27 or child will be removed from team. Fee includes instruction time, **custom fit** performance costume, poms and invite fees.
