ORDINANCE NO. 13, SERIES OF 2011

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 26 MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC,
ARTICLE III PARKING REGULATIONS SECTION 65 - STOPPING OR PARKING
PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN SPECIFIED AREAS (a)(3) OF THE
VILLAGE OF LITTLE CHUTE MUNICIPAL CODE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Board of Trustees, Village of Little Chute, Outagamie County, Wisconsin as follows:

Section I. Chapter 26 – Article III - Section 65 (a)(3) of the Village of Little Chute Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows.

Sec. 26-65 Stopping or parking prohibited in certain specified places.

- (a) Parking prohibited at all times; exception. Except temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading or in receiving or discharging passengers or property and while the vehicle is attended by a licensed operator so that it may be moved promptly in case of an emergency or to avoid obstruction of traffic, no person shall at any time park or leave standing any vehicle.
- (3) On a sidewalk or terrace area, except when parking in such place is clearly indicated by official traffic signs or markers or parking meters. The term "terrace or sidewalk area" means that ~~area between the sidewalk and the nearest curbline running parallel or generally parallel thereto or in the absence of a sidewalk 12 feet beyond the curbline~~ as defined in Section 40-148.

Section II: Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the above provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or its applications.

Section III: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective on the date of passage and posting or publication.
