Proclamation—Honoring 3 Little Chute Jets Football Coaches For Over 20 Years of Service

Action—Adopt Resolution #32 Rescinding the Resolution of September 30, 2015 to Withdraw from the Wisconsin Public Employers' Group Health Insurance Program

Administrator Fenlon stated that a Resolution was signed on September to withdraw from the Wisconsin Public Employers' Group Health Insurance Program pending an offer from a private health insurance company. Staff recommendation is to stay with the State Health Insurance Program for 2016.

Discussion—2016 Budget

Director Matheny gave an overview of the budgets for Administration, Community Development, Clerk, Village Hall, Municipal Court, Public Safety, Fire Operations, Department of Parks, Recreation and Forestry and Public Works. The Board agreed to add an 8 hour a week evidence clerk to the Fox Valley Metro Police Departments budget for 2016.

Discussion—Health Insurance Opt Out

Administrator Fenlon stated employees who are eligible for health insurance through the Village of Little Chute, but opt to have coverage through a spouse or other coverage from an outside source are eligible to select a payment in lieu of health coverage through the Village of Little Chute. Regular full-time employees who are on family plans will be paid \$4800 and \$2400 a year for the single plan. Regular part-time employees that work at least 29 hours per week will receive \$3600 per year for the family plan and \$1800 for the single plan. Administrator Fenlon stated to be eligible the employee must provide evidence of other health insurance coverage and participation on this program is only available during the open enrollment period unless there is a life event.

Moved by Trustee Elrick, seconded by Trustee Peterson to allow Village employees to Opt-Out of the Village's Healthcare Plan.




