**ORDINANCE NO. 2 , SERIES OF 2016**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FEES UNDER APPENDIX B AND C,  
OF THE VILLAGE OF LITTLE CHUTE MUNICIPAL CODE.**

WHEREAS, the Appropriate Staff of the Village of Little Chute has recommended the following ordinance amendments; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees, Village of Little Chute, finds the following ordinance amendments to be in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of Trustees, Village of Little Chute, do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** That the Appendix B – Park Impact Fees (9) of the Municipal Code of the Village of Little Chute are hereby increased and amended as follows:

**Appendix B - PARK IMPACT FEES**

**9. - Impact fees [imposition and payment].**

The above-referenced impact fee of \$200.00\$500.00 is in addition to land costs. Land costs are not part of the \$200.00\$500.00 impact fee set forth above. The \$200.00\$500.00 impact fee above is not subject to reduction under standard 10.d. below.

**12. - Review.** The impact fees contained herein shall be reviewed by the village board periodically as reasonable or necessary.

**ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

**ORDINANCE NO. 3, SERIES OF 2016**

**AN ANNEXATION ORDINANCE ADOPTED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF  
LITTLE CHUTE PURSUANT TO SECTION 66.0217 OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES,  
ANNEXING TERRITORY FROM THE TOWN OF VANDENBROEK.**

WHEREAS, a Petition for Direct Annexation (Outagamie County) has been presented to the Village of Little Chute under statutory authority 66.0217(2), Wisconsin Statutes as amended; and,

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners of the property within the proposed area for annexation; and,

WHEREAS, said Petition for Annexation and Notice contains a legal description of the territory proposed to be annexed sufficiently accurate to determine its location, designates the area to be annexed to the Village of Little Chute and designates the area as being proposed to be detached from the Town of Vandenbroek as located in Outagamie County; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Little Chute Board of Trustees has determined that the proposed annexation is in the best interests of the Village of Little Chute and the owners of real estate in the proposed annexation area; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Little Chute Plan Commission has reviewed and recommended in favor of the proposed annexation; and,

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Administration has reviewed the annexation petition and found it to be in the public interest; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Board has reviewed advice received from the Wisconsin Department of Administration; and,

WHEREAS, an Annexation Ordinance of the proposed territory by the Village of Little Chute requires a two-thirds vote of the governing body (Board of Trustees) of the Village of Little Chute;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Little Chute as located in Outagamie County, State of Wisconsin as follows:

1. That the real estate located within the SE ¼ Section 9 T21N R18E Described as: CSM #6983 Lot 1 of Recorded Document Number 2041137 and CSM #7154 Lot 1 of Recorded Document Number 2069034. Described area containing 21.008 Acres M/L, which is the same real estate as set forth in the Annexation Petition, be hereby annexed to the Village of Little Chute as located in Outagamie County, State of Wisconsin.

2. The territory is annexed to the Village for zoning purposes as: ID Industrial District

3. That a scale map of the area, showing the boundaries of annexation territory and its relationship to the boundaries of the Village of Little Chute, is hereby adopted by reference.

4. The current population of the territory being annexed is zero (0) persons, determined in accordance with the definition under Section 66.0217(3), Wisconsin Statutes.

5. This Annexation Ordinance shall be effective upon its enactment by a two-thirds vote of the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Little Chute.

6. The Village Clerk of the Village of Little Chute shall file with the Wisconsin Secretary of State a certified copy of this Annexation Ordinance and with each company providing utility services in the area annexed. One original copy of this Annexation Ordinance shall be provided to the Outagamie County Register of Deeds for recording/filing purposes, and one certified copy shall be filed with the Clerk of each affected school district and township.

7. The Finance Director of the Village shall pay to the Town Clerk the amount of \$24.80 which represents total reimbursement of town portion of the property tax of the area annexed over a five year period.

**EXPLANATION:**

Parking has been problematic behind the Safety Center particularly with the activities at the school and baseball diamonds (+ road construction). We would like to restrict parking directly behind the station, basically everything east of the entryway from Pierce/Legion Parkway for Police & Fire Department personnel only. The Fire Department has experienced parking issues and access to the lot on several occasions.

From the Fire Chief:

“Just to add some input into the parking situation, Saturday we had a call in the afternoon in which the parking lot was full, and also Monday evening shortly after 6:00 we had another call where not only was the lot full with the exception of the two marked stalls behind the station but some of our personnel could not enter in to the back lot at all due to the fact a game had just finished.”

**EXPLANATION:** The reconstruction of the Doyle Park Basketball and Tennis Courts was approved in the 2016 Capital Improvement Plan at \$75,000. The amount requested and approved covers reconstructing the existing 2 basketball and 2 tennis courts and converting them into 1 basketball and 1 tennis court.

The Village received bids on Friday, June 24. The bids included a base bid with 1 basketball and 1 tennis court and an alternate bid that included 2 tennis courts and 1 basketball court. The alternate bid would only be possible with a USTA grant. The two bids are located below. We have 90 days to award the project

**MCC INC**

**Base Bid - \$85,253.62**

**Alternate Bid - \$71,403.17**

**NORTHEAST ASPHALT INC.**

**Base Bid - \$96,100.00**

**Alternate Bid - \$73,850.00**

We are 1 month into the USTA Grant process. The process takes 3 – 5 months to reach a conclusion. The Village could receive up to \$20,000 towards the project. More than likely we will receive less than \$20,000 due to the size of our project.

At this time, I recommend that we wait a few more weeks and see how our first technical review comes in from the USTA Engineer team. In the mean time I would like to contact MCC Inc. as the low bidder and let them know of our intentions with waiting a few weeks on the USTA grant. From there we can formulate a plan with them for the project if it gets later into fall.



**ADMINISTRATOR'S REVIEW/COMMENTS: ( See Below )**

**EXPLANATION:** As the work on McKinley and Grand continues to progress, the Village had been working with LCASD staff to discuss lighting around the school. Kaukauna Utilities would normally install wood poles after construction so that the street lighting was adequate. This is done at no charge to the Village except for the monthly/annual electric costs. Just like in the Central Business District or on the plaza, an alteration from the wood pole to any upgrade is the responsibility of the municipality or owner.

After having the opportunity to meet with Dave Botz this week, it is the LCASD wish that the lighting is upgraded due to all the improvements being made in the roadway around the elementary school. In our discussion, the school district views their investment in the new road as an opportunity to showcase the school and ensure that when the new lights are put in, that the area is presentable and a showcase. Part of that improvement from the School District's view is an upgrade to the lighting.

Attached to this document, you will notice an aerial lighting plan provided by KU that shows 7 lights on school district property and 2 lights on Legion Park/Village property. In addition, there are two options for upgraded light (memo from KU attached shows differences), a Razor Series (\$850/each) and the downtown candy cane pole from Sun Valley Lighting (\$2,880). In my discussions with Dave, we agreed that the Razor Series would be sufficient and appropriate in this instance.

Also, in my discussion with Dave Botz, I offered to take this proposal to the Board with the recommendation that the Village and School District split the cost of the upgraded Razor lights for the 7 on school property. In addition, in order to keep the area consistent, I would recommend that the Village install Razor Lights for the two at Legion Park. This would mean that the Village would be responsible for roughly \$4,675 (\$1,700 for two Legion Park lights and \$2,975 for 50% of the costs of 7 lights on LCASD property).

For your reference, you will also note that I have attached a memo from KU providing data on the light costs, in addition to specs on the two separate lights offered. In conclusion, while this may be out of the ordinary for the Village to split the cost with an organization on the lighting, this area is one that will continue to see increased traffic as Legion Park continues to redevelop. While it is not the Central Business District, I would argue that having this area have a cleaner appearance is a benefit to not only our residents, but visitors. Finally, in working with Dave and the LCASD on this effort, it is apparent that this upgraded feature is important to them as an organization and I see a benefit to working collaboratively while also upgrading the lighting in the school and Legion Park area.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Discuss the alternative lighting plan and approve working with the Little Chute Area School District to upgrade the 9 lights on Grand Avenue and McKinley Avenue around the Elementary School and Legion Park.






