Discussion—Election Equipment Procurement

Clerk Decker presented the IFC for the Intergovernmental Agreement and Resolution from Outagamie County for the purchase of new election equipment. The approved Resolution approves a 50/50 cost share for one new machine for each polling location, three machines are needed for the Village of Little Chute. As pricing is highly dependent upon the number of units purchased, it is necessary to obtain commitments from municipalities well ahead of any purchase to determine an accurate cost estimate. There will be a seven member procurement team formed and Clerk Decker has put her name in to be considered. Clerk Decker will bring the Intergovernmental Agreement for action to a future board meeting.

Discussion—Fireworks Ordinance

Administrator Fenlon presented the board with information regarding the request to discharge fireworks by Rainbow Play Systems and the ordinances currently in place by Kimberly and Little Chute. The Village of Kimberly amended their ordinance to add “any individual or group of individuals”. The Fire Chief went to Rainbow Play Systems, 3001 Spirit Court, Appleton and spoke to a neighboring business, “Power Sports” and they are in support of it. The Fire Chief also recommends approval of a permit for this event. Trustee Peterson requested more information from the Insurance Company. Trustee Smith wants to make sure the fire department is involved and have clear guidelines in place on where fireworks can be discharged and who will be allowed. Trustee Peterson also voiced concerns on drawing the line on who will be allowed to set off fireworks. Trustee Peerenboom and Trustee Smith moved to add this to the June 7, 2017 Board Meeting.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REVIEW/COMMENTS: (See Below)

EXPLANATION: Over the course of the last week, staff has diligently researched what other communities use to control the discharge of fireworks in municipalities across the state. What we found, regardless of any current requests on the table, is that our ordinance is restrictive. As mentioned in the previous meeting, there would be few instances or no instances in which a permit could responsibly be issued to a private group of individuals.

All that said, what staff found is that some municipalities have created a very thorough and detailed permit. In these municipalities, they control the permit issuance through stringent standards that must be met by the applicant in order to seek approval from the Chief of the Fire Department, the Chief of the Police Department and the Community Development Director/Zoning Administrator.

What is attached to this document is the potential changes to the ordinance, which are very limited. This change would be consistent with the Village of Kimberly. What you will also find is a DRAFT permit that still has the opportunity for massaging or editing. We strongly urge the board to review the permit and provide recommendations that they feel provide adequate control, while allowing responsible parties to effectively use fireworks.

We welcome comments and questions you have ahead of the meeting as well.

1. To pay the required permit fee at the time of application (\$100.00)
2. To abide by the "Requirements for Fireworks/Pyrotechnics Displays within the Village of Little Chute," and provide all the information requested therein.
3. To furnish the Village of Little Chute Fire Department with a list of all fireworks/pyrotechnics prior to use, including bill(s) of lading, and copies of operator's credentials.
4. To comply with all Wisconsin Statutes, Village of Little Chute ordinances, and NFPA 1123 Code for Fireworks Displays (for fireworks permit), NFPA-1124 (Manufacture, Transportation, Storage and Retail Sale of Fireworks and Pyrotechnics) and NFPA 160 (Standard for Flame Effects).
5. To provide qualified pyro technicians who shall deliver, set up, execute and dismantle the fireworks/pyrotechnics display and shall conduct an after-display search of the grounds in an effort to locate and dispose of any unexploded fireworks/pyrotechnics.
6. The Lead Operator must have Pyrotechnics Guild International Display Operator Certification, or a certification or training greater than a PGI certification.
7. To file a Certificate of Insurance naming the Village of Little Chute as an additional insured for fireworks/pyrotechnics display held under this permit in an aggregate amount of \$1,000,000.00 or more, specific to the date and type of activity, not less than 15 days prior to the issuance of this permit.
8. A violation of any of the terms and conditions herein shall be cause of immediate revocation of this permit and subject the applicant to any citations or fines as allowed by Wisconsin Statute or Village of Little Chute ordinance.

I am authorized to make this application and bind the Permit Holder and Display Operator, respectively, to the agreements and representations made in this application. I, on behalf of the Permit Holder, and Display Operator, respectively, agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Village (its officers, elected officials, agents and citizens) against any injuries and damages resulting or arising from the fireworks/pyrotechnics display and shall pay all judgments, costs and charges that may be recovered against the Village (its officers, elected officials, agents and citizens) by reasons of the conduct of such fireworks/pyrotechnics display, together with the cost of defending any such action against the Village, including actual attorney's fees. I hereby accept the conditions of this privilege and agree to abide by all terms and conditions, as well as include the Village of Little Chute as an additional insured on the Certificate of Insurance.

ORDINANCE NO. 3, SERIES OF 2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10 - BUSINESS LICENSING AND REGULATIONS ARTICLE VIII. - FIREWORKS SECTION 10-191. - USE. OF THE VILLAGE OF LITTLE CHUTE MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees, Village of Little Chute, finds the following ordinance amendments to be in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of Trustees, Village of Little Chute, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Business Licensing and regulation Ordinance, Section Sec. 10-191. - Use. of the Municipal Code of the Village of Little Chute is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 10-191. - Use.

- (a) *Permit required.* No person may possess or use fireworks without a user's permit from the village president or from an official or employee of the village as designated by the village board. No person may use a device listed under the definition of fireworks in section 10-189(5) through (7) and (9) through (14) while attending a fireworks display for which a permit has been issued to a person listed under subsection (c)(1)—(5) of this section or under subsection (c)(6) of this section if the display is open to the general public.
- (b) *Permit exceptions.* Subsection (a) of this section does not apply to:
 - (1) The village, except that village fire and law enforcement officials shall be notified of the proposed use of fireworks at least two days in advance.
 - (2) The possession or use of explosives in accordance with rules or general orders of the Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations.
 - (3) The disposal of hazardous substances in accordance with rules adopted by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
 - (4) The possession or use of explosive or combustible materials in connection with classes conducted by educational institutions.
 - (5) A possessor or manufacturer of explosives in possession of a license or permit under 18 USC 841 to 848 if the possession of the fireworks is authorized under the license or permit.
- (c) *Who may obtain permit.* A permit under this section may be issued only to the following:
 - (1) A public authority.
 - (2) A fair association.
 - (3) An amusement park.
 - (4) A park board.
 - (5) A civic organization.

(6) An agricultural producer for the protection of crops from predatory birds or animals.

(7) Any individual or group of individuals

- (d) *Crop protection signs.* A person issued a permit for crop protection shall erect appropriate warning signs disclosing the use of fireworks for crop protection.
- (e) *Bond.* The village president issuing a permit under this section shall require an indemnity bond with good and sufficient sureties or policy of liability insurance for the payment of all claims that may arise by reason of injuries to person or property from the handling, use or discharge of fireworks under the permit. The bond or policy shall be taken in the name of the village, and any person injured thereby may bring an action on the bond or policy in the person's own name to recover the damage the person has sustained, but the aggregate liability of the surety or insurer to all persons shall not exceed the amount of the bond or policy. The bond or policy, persons shall not exceed the amount of the bond or policy. The bond or policy, together with a copy of the permit, shall be filed in the office of the village. +
- (f) *Required information for permit.* A permit under this section shall specify all of the following:
- (1) The name and address of the permit holder.
 - (2) The date on and after which fireworks may be purchased.
 - (3) The kind and quantity of fireworks which may be purchased.
 - (4) The date and location of permitted use.
 - (5) Other special conditions prescribed by ordinance.
- (g) *Copy of permit.* A copy of a permit under this section shall be given to the fire chief and chief of police at least two days before the date of authorized use.
- (h) *Minors prohibited.* A permit under this section may not be issued to a minor.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon the adoption and publication and enactment of the Ordinance by the Village Board of Trustees, Village of Little Chute.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

The County would like to encourage municipalities within Outagamie County to obtain updated and consistent voting machines that will enhance accuracy, timely reporting of results and create an auditable trail of the tabulations.

The County Clerk is undergoing a procurement exercise that includes municipal officials to determine the voting machine that would best suit the needs of municipalities at the most reasonable price.

This intergovernmental agreement sets forth the terms and conditions for a 50-50 cost sharing arrangement between the county and individual municipalities.

As pricing is highly dependent upon the number of units purchased, it is necessary to obtain commitments from municipalities well ahead of any purchase in order to determine an accurate cost estimate.

The Outagamie County Board of Supervisors has adopted a resolution that enables the County Clerk to gauge the degree of interest municipalities have in purchasing new and uniform voting machines on a 50-50 cost share basis. The County Board has not yet appropriated funding for such a purpose until final cost estimates are established. At that time, the board will consider the amount of the county's share as well as the number of municipal participants when it votes on the appropriation.

AGREEMENT

Outagamie County and Village of Little Chute, Municipality, for good and valuable consideration agree as follows:

1. Outagamie County will purchase the voting machines through a competitive procurement process consistent with Outagamie County purchasing policies. Further guidelines for the procurement are set forth in County Board Resolution No. 4--2017-2018, a copy of which is attached for reference.

2. Municipality agrees to reimburse Outagamie County for 50 percent of the purchase cost by the Municipality. The Municipality shall check one of the following options to reimburse Outagamie County and will be bound by the terms of the chosen payment option:

____ No Financing. Municipality will pay its 50 percent share of the purchase price to Outagamie County in full on July 1, 2018.

____ Five-Year Financing. Municipality will pay its 50 percent share of the purchase price to Outagamie County based upon a five year amortization of the principle amount, plus interest. Interest shall be the same rate of interest the county pays on its debt. Payments will be made annually, commencing on July 1, 2018, and annually thereafter until paid in full.

____ Ten Year Financing. Municipality will pay its 50 percent share of the purchase price to Outagamie County based upon a ten year amortization of the principle amount, plus interest. Interest shall be the same rate of interest the county pays on its debt. Payments will be made annually, commencing on July 1, 2018, and annually thereafter until paid in full.

Failure to pay by above listed July 1 due dates will result in an additional .5% per month charge until such principal and interest amounts due are paid in full.

3. Outagamie County will not participate in this cost sharing arrangement beyond the initial procurement. Municipalities that may decide to purchase voting equipment beyond the initial procurement shall pay 100 percent of the purchase price of those voting machines.

4. Municipalities shall be 100 percent responsible for any equipment and software maintenance, programming and replacement of voting machines procured through this agreement.

5. The number of voting machines that may be purchased through the terms of this agreement shall be determined by the chosen vendor based upon the number of residents in the Municipality or precincts within the Municipality who voted in the 2016 presidential election.

A. If the Municipality wishes to purchase a machine(s) in excess of the number determined by the vendor, the Municipality shall pay 100 percent of the cost of such excess machine(s).

B. Municipalities with multi-county polling locations shall fund 100 percent of machines purchased through this agreement for machines utilized in locations with a majority of non-Outagamie County residents.

6. The County will fund 100 percent of two back-up machines which will be available to municipalities in the event of equipment failure.

7. The terms and conditions of this agreement are contingent upon the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors' appropriation of funds for the purchase of the voting machines. Upon adoption of the appropriating resolution, both parties to this agreement are bound by the terms and conditions contained herein.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REVIEW/COMMENTS: (See Below)

EXPLANATION: From February through present, the Board has been presented with a host of information on marketing and branding through our partnership with Jenny Vanden Huevel. Over that time, we have taken input from staff, the Business Community and citizens through an online survey. In addition to those efforts, we hosted an open house here at Village Hall.

At the heart of this discussion, our end goal is to have a logo and standards that can be used in different settings, has adequate resolution and options for the various types of use that a logo in the 21st century is used. While the current logo is not inadequate, the stock images we have and the manner in which the name and types of current documents is inadequate.

That being said, the choice before you on June 7th is down to two options:

- 1- Current logo with updated images (high quality). This would include a clean-up of imperfections while also creating brand standards that can be applied for future deployment of village branding efforts.
- 2- Updated logo with the different types of images to support use in a diverse deployment of village branding efforts.

Ms. Vanden Heuvel will present a brief PowerPoint that illustrates what the updated logo would look like, along with options and flexibility within that design framework, including brand standard description.

Finally, I think it is worth mentioning that there is no "right" answer here. On one hand, we have a logo that has been used for nearly thirty years and has served the village well. In addition, that logo is not bad. What is challenging is the lack of standards and ability to apply it uniformly in diverse settings. There are options by which updating the current logo could overcome the current challenges faced in a diverse media atmosphere that currently exists.

An updated logo was discussed due to the fact that if we were going to be "refreshing" the current logo, we had an opportunity to discuss a larger scale rebrand. We are now at the point that the ultimate decision must be made. If you have questions upon reading this or would like to see additional or different information leading up to the meeting, please contact me.

RECOMMENDATION: Take action and provide direction on what logo/branding the Board of Trustees would like to see so that the village can appropriately market the village. This will include the use of brand standards and appropriate use of future logos.
