MCO Operations Update

Jerry Verstegen, MCO, presented an update and advised that a 12" transmission line ruptured and had to be repaired immediately. Residential meter readings are continuing and the Lead and Copper ordinance should be completed in time for next meeting. Regarding Well #1, well pumps are in with little issues. There is a crack in the intake line that will be repaired by Speedy Clean. Waiting for programmer to return and chemical pumps to arrive to complete project.

Director of Public Works

Director Elrick reported the sewers ran well with only a slight flooding on Wilson. The Ammonia Nitrogen billing is being processed. Discussion on Agropur having had a problem with their system going down and had to drain, thought it was solved and had to drain again and are being billed. Discussed random water testing at Little Chute businesses.

Finance Director

Work orders are being done on an I Pad and still working on issues but once working it will save on paper. Director Matheny does not expect any rate changes in 2018 for Sewer or Storm. Still trying to

get more customers on the PSN online billing system, suggested maybe a promotion with prizes to get more customers to sign up.




