



April 8-12 denotes Tornado and Severe Weather Awareness Week in the State of Wisconsin. The Village of Little Chute has partnered with Outagamie County and will be providing a very limited number of NOAA weather radios at no charge to Village of Little Chute residents at a first come first served basis. Weather radios (when plugged in and turned on) provide updated local weather and severe weather alerts and can be excellent resource for individuals who do not have internet connections or cellular phones with emergency alert capabilities. The Village of Little Chute would like to provide these radios

to residents who may not have access to the internet or cellular phones and would benefit from having a weather radio in their home.



Radios will be available starting **April 8th** to Village Residents with a limit of one per household. Please stop in the Clerk's Office in Village Hall during our normal office hours (8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.) to pick up your radio. No reservations will be accepted over the phone or through email, radios must be picked up in person by those interested, while supplies last.
