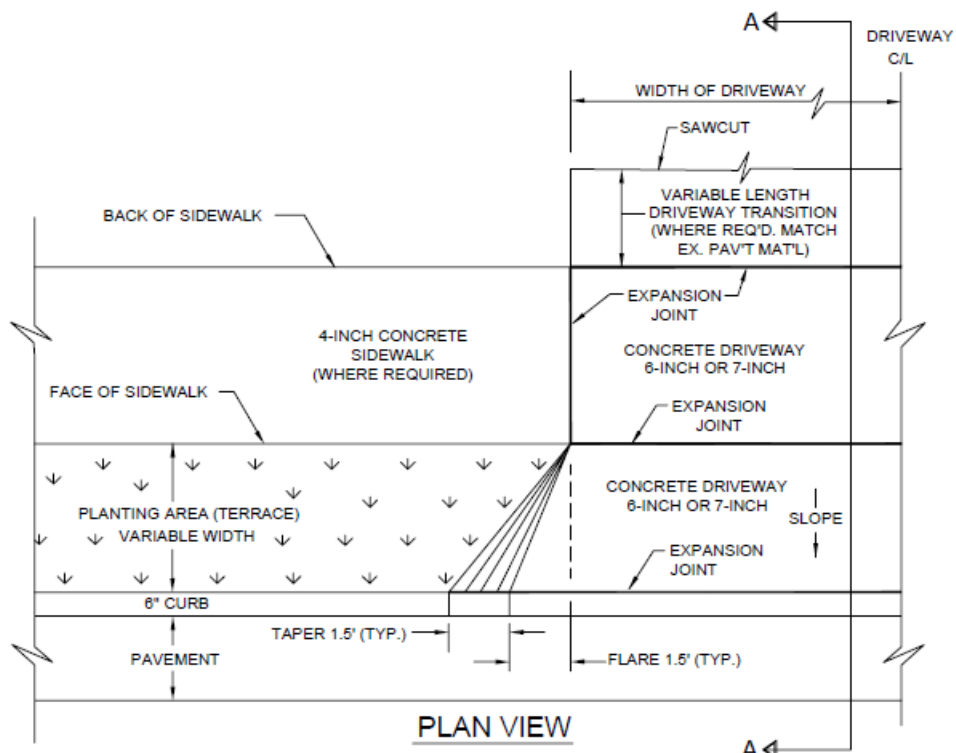
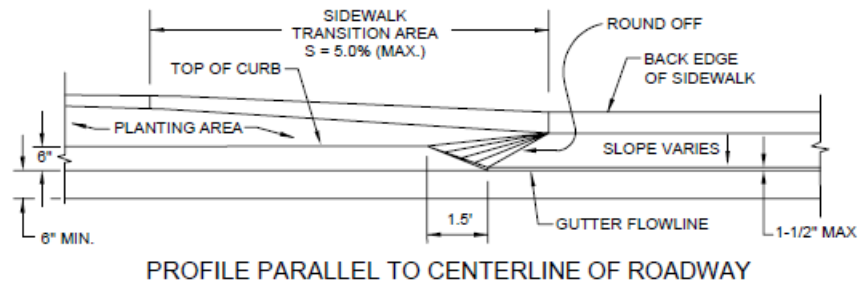
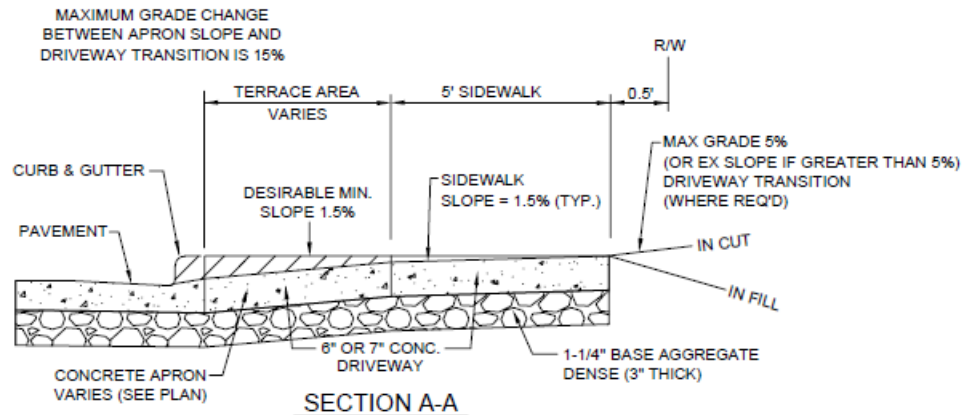

### GENERAL NOTES FOR DRIVEWAYS AND SIDEWALKS

- LOCATIONS FOR DRIVEWAY OPENINGS AND LENGTH OF TRANSITION AREAS FOR DRIVEWAYS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE ENGINEER IN THE FIELD.
- ALL RESIDENTIAL DRIVEWAY APRONS AND SIDEWALK THROUGH DRIVEWAYS SHALL BE REPLACED WITH 6-INCH CONCRETE OVER 3" OF 1-1/4" BASE AGGREGATE DENSE.
- ALL COMMERCIAL DRIVEWAY APRONS AND SIDEWALK THROUGH DRIVEWAYS SHALL BE REPLACED WITH 7-INCH CONCRETE OVER 3" OF 1-1/4" BASE AGGREGATE DENSE.
- NO STEEL (WIRE MESH, REBAR, ETC.) ALLOWED IN FLATWORK WITHIN PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY.
- CONTRACTOR SHALL DIE STAMP ALL CONCRETE POURED WITHIN PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY.
